New Programme PROGRESS (2007-2013)

The European Commission has launched a single new Programme called PROGRESS, merging the current action programmes and budget lines covering anti-discrimination, gender equality, fighting social exclusion and promoting employment.

The aim of bringing together the above-mentioned action programmes and budget lines is to simplify the way the EC spends its money and to increase the visibility, clarity and coherence of the different policy areas covered.

Structure and types of activities

The Programme is organised in 5 sections:

- employment
- social protection and social inclusion
- working conditions
- anti-discrimination and diversity
- gender equality

and covers the following types of activities:

- Analytical activities, such as collecting and disseminating data, carrying out studies, analyses and impact assessments, and using statistics and evaluation methods.
- Activities involving mutual learning, exchange of information, awareness raising, good practices and measures related to monitoring and evaluation in Member States and to improving the application of Community rules.
- Activities supporting stakeholders aimed at promoting exchange of good practice and sharing of information (e.g. networks at EU level).
