Call for proposals 2006 on follow up and dissemination activities of the "Mutual Learning Programme" in the European Employment Strategy

The European Commission has launched a Call for Proposals in the framework of the "Mutual Learning Programme", created to exchanging good practice and experiences within and between Member States on the European Employment Strategy.

# **Objectives**

- To develop partnerships or networks
- To encourage mutual learning within Member States and between Member States
- To promote a wider and more effective dissemination of knowledge about the European Employment Strategy

### **Priorities**

Proposed actions should be linked to one of the following priorities:

- Effective implementation of reforms through better governance
- Increasing adaptability of workers and enterprises
- Attracting more people to enter and remain on the labour market
- Investing more and more effectively in human capital and lifelong learning

# Types of activities and transnationality

- Meetings, workshops, seminars
- Policy recommendations based on the results of European Social Fund co-financed projects in Member States
- Information campaigns and awareness raising activities
- Networks

These activities may be also combined with studies, literature and desk reviews, study visits.

The project proposals must be presented by bodies in at least 2 Member States.

# What scale of funding is available?

The amount available for this Call is € 900,000, according to the quality of received proposals.

The EU contribution may not exceed 75% of the total eligible project costs; the cofinancing amount cannot exceed € 250,000.

### Timetable and deadline

The application must be sent at the latest on **30.06.2006**.

The minimum duration of a project will be 6 months and the maximum will be 18 months.

# Submission of the application

Applications must be

- 1. submitted on-line with all the attached annexes and be sent by post in triplicate (one marked as "original", and two marked as "copy")
- 2. signed by the applicant's legal representative
- 3. submitted by 30.06.2006
- 4. posted to:
