# YOUTH PROGRAMME

Cooperation, training and information in the field of non-formal education Call for proposals

The European Commission has launched a Call for proposals, in the framework of YOUTH PROGRAMME, aimed at supporting innovative cooperation, training and information projects in the field of non-formal education.

# **Priorities**

The priority themes to be considered for proposals are:

- Cultural diversity and tolerance
- Less favoured regions
- Eastern Europe-Caucasus-South East Europe
- Innovation in European Citizenship Education
- Cooperation between local or regional authorities and youth NGOs.

It is essential that the proposal contains innovative elements and a clear transnational European dimension, setting up or consolidating strong partnerships between youth organisations or between youth organisations and public bodies.

# Participating countries and transnationality

The Call is open to non-governmental youth organisations and local and regional authorities established in the countries participating in the YOUTH Programme, i.e.:

- the 25 FU Member States
- the 3 EFTA/EEA countries: Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway
- Candidate countries: Bulgaria, Romania, Turkey

Organisations from neighbouring countries of the EU (Algeria, Egypt, Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, Morocco, Syria, Tunisia, the Palestinian Authority, Belarus, Moldova, Russia, Ukraine, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Georgia, Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Macedonia, Serbia and Montenegro) may participate only as partners.

The proposal has to be submitted by a partnership composed of at least 4 participating countries, including the applicant, one of which has to be an EU Member State.

# **Duration of projects**

18 months from the signature of the contract (if justified, a maximum duration of up to 36 months will be accepted).

Project activities must start between 1/1/2007 and 28/2/2007.

# **Funding**

The maximum grant per project will not exceed € 100,000 per 12 months of activity, and the maximum grant will not exceed € 300,000. The EC expects to fund 10-15 high quality projects.
